Zoe Zenghelis (1937) is an Athens-born British artist. She received her first lessons in painting from Oresti Canellis in Athens, then, between 1956-61, she continued to study first in stage design and then in painting at the Regent Street Polytechnic in London under Frank Auerbach, Lawrence Gowing, and Leon Kossoff. Space, colour, light and form were her obsession since the very beginning. They were lenses through which she sees the world; a colourful melancholic stage set, wherein human emotions, feelings, and relations burst into shades of colours, geometric planes, and grids. In fact one could claim that Zoe's painting has never changed throughout her career, she just began to see adopted vista and reflected them on her canvas. From her early sketches of a stage set to a metropolitan landscape, or an architectural component, she explores and reconstructs a reality into lyrical compositions of colours and forms. Since 1972 she re-established her painting career as a founding member of OMA (Office for Metropolitan Architecture, officially founded in 1975), whose collaboration with other OMA founding members- Rem Koolhaas, Elia Zenghelis, and Madelon Vriesendorp- has widened their horizons and opened new opportunities for them in painting and architecture. Her paintings for OMA have been exhibited in many major museums and galleries across the world. Zenghelis's independent works as a painter have been widely exhibited and published since 1985 when she had her major solo exhibition at the Architectural Association in London. The paintings are inspired by metropolitan structure, landform, and abstract tectonics. Yet the imagery is quintessentially modern and modernist: it is an imagery of the fragment, the collage, the assemblage, the parts standing for the whole, and often greater than the whole. From 1982 to 1993, in partnership with Madelon Vriesendorp, she ran the Colour Workshop at the Architectural Association School of Architecture.
